Boards and Commissions



Pantego Economic Development Corporation


Pantego Economic Development Corporation (PEDC) meets on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month. Meetings are held at the Town Council Chamber located at 1614 South Bowen Road. The PEDC is responsible for administration of the 1/2-cent 4B Economic Development Sales Tax. The PEDC oversee projects funded by this tax, which have included building the law enforcement center, construction of several drainage projects and creek channeling, and development of Pantego's Bicentennial Park. The Board of Directors consists of eight directors, three to four Council Members and three to four citizens. The City Manager acts as the Executive Director and is the staff liaison to the PEDC.



The Community Relations Board

The Community Relations Board meets on the first Tuesday of each month. Meetings are held at the Town Council Chambers located at 1614 South Bowen Road and start at 7:00 p.m. The Community Relations Board consists of a combination of members from our Park and Recreation Board and Public Safety Advisory as well as Council and Staff liaisons. This Board is responsible for development and administration of the towns public activities such as the Easter Egg Hunt, Memorial Day Concert in the Park, 4th of July Concert in the Park, Labor Day Concert in the Park, Pumpkin Path, and the Christmas Tree Lighting. The members are appointed by Council and serve two year terms.

Planning and Zoning Commission



The Planning and Zoning Commission meets on the first Monday of each month as needed. Meetings are held at the Town Council Chamber located at 1614 South Bowen Road and start at 7:00 p.m. The Town of Pantego established the Planning and Zoning Commission to hear and consider any matters related to zoning, planned developments, and sub-dividing land within the corporate limits of the Town and forward their recommendations to the Town Council. The Planning and Zoning Commission also considers applications for special use permits and changes to the Town's Zoning Ordinances and makes recommendations to the Town Council for approval or denial. The P&Z consists of seven commissioners and four alternates. The city manager, building official, and the P&Z secretary serve as staff liaisons.



Zoning Board of Appeals

The Board of Development Appeals (Zoning Board of Adjustment) meets on the third Thursday of each month as needed. Meetings are held at the Town Council Chamber, 1614 South Bowen Road and start at 7:00 p.m. The Town of Pantego created the Board of Development Appeals (Zoning Board of Appeals) to hear and consider applications or variances from the requirements of the Town's Zoning Ordinances. This board was granted quasi-judicial powers to approve or deny requester's relief from building, plumbing, and other development codes and/or from orders issued by the building inspector.

All members to these boards and commissions are appointed by the Town Council in May of each year and serve for a two year term.
