The Town of Pantego is gearing up to hold its inaugural PantegoFEST October 5, 6, and 7, 2012 celebrating the small town charm of Pantego! The goal of the festival is to showcase the wonderful business community and bring new customers to this great town. The festival will feature several events throughout the weekend, including live entertainment, a custom and classic car show, homebrewing demonstrations, and a Kids Safe Play Zone.

A one day entry ticket for Friday, Saturday or Sunday is **\$6.00** or a weekend pass can be purchased for **\$10.00**! Tickets are available for purchase online, picked up in person at Town Hall and they'll be available for purchase at the gate! A party tent will also be available to enjoy the concert at a cost of **\$25.00** for a one-day pass or **\$40.00** for the weekend!

Other events to look forward to during the three day festival include a one mile fun run and 5k road race taking place Saturday morning, October 6th where participants will travel through the streets of Pantego.

From 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., runners will take to the streets! The route for the 5k race will begin on Bowen Rd at The Towers shopping center. The first leg of the race will be in westerly direction traveling on Miller Ln, Oakridge Dr, Cresthaven Dr, Kidd Dr, Silverleaf Dr, Peachtree Ln, Arrowhead Dr, Stagecoach Dr, Chisholm Trl, and back to Peachtree Ln.

The second leg will loop back to the east along Country Club Rd, Peachtree Ln, Silverleaf Dr, Dickerson Dr, Conley Dr, Hilltop Ln, Peachtree Ln, Cresthaven Dr, Oakridge Dr, Miller Ln, and back to the start at Park Row and Bowen.

EAST side of Park Row: parking will be available in a grassy lot just north of the Pantego Police Department
WEST side of Park Row: parking will be available in the Park Row West shopping center and the Village Park shopping center. Parking will also be available to the NORTH of Park Row in the Chase Bank parking lot.
