**Qualifications:**

- Applicant must be **21** years of age by employment date.
- Applicant must complete a **Town of Pantego** employment application.
- Applicant must be certified in **Structural Fire Suppression** by the Texas **Commission on Fire Protection** by date of employment.
- Applicant must be certified by the **Texas Department of State Health Services as an Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic** at time of employment offer or a Paramedic student within six(6) months of certification. A condition of employment will include becoming certified within the six (6) months.
- Applicant must possess a class **C Texas** drivers license without more than three Class C misdemeanor traffic violations in the last three years.
- Applicant must be willing and able to obtain a Class B license (with a firefighter exemption) within 6 months of employment.
- Applicant must not have any prior **Felony** or **DWI** convictions.
- Applicant may not be color blind in both eyes.
- Applicant's visual acuity must be correctable to **20/40**.
- Applicants who have passed and possess a TCC PAT certificate dated within the six months prior to the application deadline may not be required to attend the physical ability test.
- The applicant must be able to pass an extensive background investigation including a pre-employment polygraph examination and a general pre-employment psychological examination.
- The applicant must be able to pass a standard pre-employment medical physical prior to initiating employment, and a complete physical including cardiac treadmill and strength testing, within one year of beginning employment.
